FOOD FOR THOUGHT: *'AMAZING GRACE'* Ephesians 6:24, *'Grace to all who love our Lord Jesus Christ with an undying love'*. What do we have that lasts forever? Nothing unless it's connected to Jesus. So much of life is *meaningless, shallow and hollow* but grace comes, grace stays and grace lives with those who love Jesus. And nothing can strip away that grace from our lives. It's an Amazing Grace that lives with us until Jesus returns, and no matter how deep our failures, our sin or disappointments are, God's Amazing Grace runs deeper still. Christian author C.S. Lewis captured this beautifully when He wrote: *'Grace is love that seeks you out when you have nothing to give in return. Grace is love coming at you that has nothing to do with you. Grace is being loved when you are unlovable'*. This is truly the amazing nature of God's Grace: it doesn't wait for us to deserve it; it pursues us when we don't. **CHALLENGE:** Are you trying to earn what has already been given freely to you? **ACTION:** Think of one mistake you keep reliving and replaying over in your mind and choose to live in God's Amazing Grace instead. Then write on a Post It Note *'God's Grace is Endless'* and then leave it in a prominent place in your home. Be blessed. *Pastor Steve*

I AM SECOND

We live in a 'dog-eat-dog' world that specializes in looking after Number 1. The media also teaches us not to tolerate being second, as TV programmes, adverts, billboards, magazines, newspapers and social media etc encourage us to *'be the best, have the best and look the best'*. We also live in a world where many people will do 'whatever it takes' yes, prepared to lose their dignity and self-respect to be Number 1, or be the best, or climb the business ladder to get to the top, or win the tournament. Who can forget Maradona's *'Hand of God'* goal in the 1986 World Cup? A deliberate handball that played its part in Argentina winning the competition. Maradona will always be remembered as a cheat despite his 'wonder goal' in the same game against England. Regularly sport is thrown into disarray with cheating allegations, most recently, when the Norwegian ski jumping team was accused of violating clothing regulations. Why? Because *second, runner up, loser, the silver medal position or not first* [whatever term you want to use] can be seen as defeat or failure. For so many people *'being Number 1 is number 1 on their priority list'*. Winners are remembered; runners up are not. [Can anyone remember who Bjorn Borg beat in the 1976 men's singles final at Wimbledon? [I thought not - even I had to look it up.] And while its good for schools and universities to 'push' their students, and parents to 'push' their children to 'be the best', and for people generally to strive *'to be the best that they can be'*, it's a sobering thought when Jesus says, *'Seek Ye FIRST the kingdom of God.'* [Matt 6:33] Here, Jesus is saying, that if we are to be truly *happy, content, joyful, successful and victorious* then He has to be Number 1 in our lives, not us. If the world applied that to their lives, then match-fixing, drug taking, rule breaking, faking disability and general cheating, as well as having to be the best in whatever field that is or to win or succeed at all costs, would pale into insignificance. When I am Second, then God can really start to work in my life. When I am Second then second place is good. When I am Second, God will give me better things than what Number 1 could ever give me. When I am Second, then it becomes about what God wants and not what I want. When I am Second, then I can wait patiently for God to work in my life. And when I am Second, God becomes number One and I become some one. Furthermore, when you acknowledge that your life is not your own and that God is first *in your life, your heart, your family, your decisions and your purposes*, then everything else will fall into its proper place. So, let's make sure in 2026, that 'I AM SECOND' and that JESUS IS NUMBER 1. Blessings. *Pastor*
